

- Staying with us at Kingsdown International Camping Centre you hereby agree to the site's terms and conditions.
- Strictly No loud music/radios on site & Strictly No music/radios after 10:00pm!
- We expect all guests to be respectfully quiet between 10:00pm & 7:00am as we like to promote a family, and not a festival, style atmosphere. Any loud, late night antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated in any way and persons WILL be asked to leave.
- You must inform us of any use of generators on site and any use after 10pm is not prohibited.
- Vehicles must not exceed 10mph whilst driving on the Avenue and on the camping grounds.
- All vehicle use on the camping field is down to management discretion and the weather permitting. Anyone caught whilst speeding, wheel spinning, handbrake turns or endangering others WILL be asked to leave.
- Always ensure that any vehicles are parked horizontally to the slope of the land whilst on the camping field. Vehicle use must be kept to a minimum, so please do not drive to and from the toilet block; Only use your vehicle when driving on to and leaving the camping centre.
- Bicycles, Scooter or Motorbikes should not be continuously ridden around the camping field.
- All waste must be put in the blue bins provided. (People found dumping will be charged)
- No fires or disposable BBQs are to be lit on the grass! A fire basket can be hired if needed.
- Fire Baskets and BBQs must ONLY be emptied into the metal HOT ASH BIN or left for our Site Staff to collect during your stay or following your departure.  
(Do NOT empty into hedgerows or on to the grass).
- Please ensure any surplus wood is returned to the woodpile before your departure. The site should be cleared by noon on the day of your departure unless permitted otherwise.
- Wood is sometimes available at the designated woodpile adjacent to the site's large campfire circle. No turf or trenches are to be dug! Pitches should be left as they are found.
- If a member of Staff witnesses any abuse or misuse of any knives, axes or saws within the site, they are authorised to request the item and it will be returned only to the leader in charge.
- The toilet block and wash facilities must be left clean and tidy after use. Do NOT leave rubbish bags in the toilet blocks or around the campsite = magnets for foxes and seagulls.
- Urinating /defecating in areas other than toilets is strictly prohibited and anyone caught doing so will be asked to leave immediately.
- Do not wash cooking utensils/equipment in the toilet block or directly under the water stand pipes around the fields; please use the stainless steel sinks outside of the toilet blocks.
- Leaders are held responsible for their own groups, which must be supervised at all times and any obscene language/acts of irresponsible behaviour are treated as totally unacceptable.
- Always close the beach gate behind you as this keeps the general public and riffraff out.
- The site should be cleared by noon on the day of your departure unless permitted otherwise by our Site Staff. Any time spent on the site afternoon will incur our day rate fees.
- Ensure that you have all your camping equipment before departing, including tent pegs, which cause damage to our mowers and injuries if left in the ground. (LEAVE NO TRACE)
- KICC reserves the right to instruct campers to disconnect any electrical equipment that does not meet recommended electrical safety standards.
- KICC will be responsible for the safety of the electric system to the electric socket on the hook-up points. It's the responsibility of the user to ensure that the mains electrical cable from the hook-up to the unit and the unit's installations are safe (e.g. making sure that the cables are pegged down and that the unit is up to date with all electrical safety standards).
- We do not allow dogs/pets on site apart from guide dogs.
- Good relationships are maintained with our neighbours by mutual respect & understanding. All guests are expected to uphold this arrangement. (Those who don't will be asked to leave).
- KICC will not accept any liability of any description for persons and loss or damage to property whilst using the camping centre. All visitors are advised to obtain the appropriate holiday insurance cover.
- We operate a blacklist system, whereby any serious offenders of these site rules will be stored for future reference.
